
The verses can be changed to think about many other people who help us e.g. vets, parents, friends, brother/sister etc.






The Postman




















This song can be sung with actions as follows:

During the chorus a child pretends to be the postman and walks up to the group with a bag of things to deliver. S/he 'knocks' on the door at the appropriate moment. In the link between chorus and verse, s/he takes the letter, parcel or leaflet out of the bag and shows it to the class. Then s/he delivers it to someone who mimes 'thank you'. A new child can be the next postman.





The Bin Man
