



HEALTHY LIFESTYLES

WHOLE CLASS INSTRUMENTAL TEACHING (WCIT) – INCLUDING SPECIAL SCHOOLS

Instruments involved include: violin, cello, flute, clarinet, recorder, tin whistle, cornet, trumpet, tenor horn, baritone, trombone, guitar, ukulele, keyboard, djembe, samba, mini pans, tabla and dhol.

THE WCIT PROGRAMME

Our WCIT Programme is subsidised through Arts Council England (ACE) funding and therefore costs just £896 per year for one teacher, one hour per week, for 33 weeks.

It is delivered to pupils in every Year 4 class by a SFE music teacher working in close partnership with the class teacher for a session of about 45 minutes per class each week.

Each session will provide a variety of linked activities including singing and opportunities for composition and improvisation.

Each child will be loaned a free instrument which, after careful preparation and training, they will be able to take home for practice.

WCIT FOR SPECIAL SCHOOLS

We also offer WCIT in special schools. This is delivered by a trained workforce of specialist music teachers, all of whom have undertaken a PGCert – Sounds of Intent (University of Roehampton) for Music and Special Needs.

We firmly believe that musical education can have a hugely positive impact and have witnessed a clear increase in confidence, team work and focus in the pupils we work with.

INSTRUMENTAL AND VOCAL TUITION IN SCHOOLS – INDIVIDUAL OR SMALL GROUPS

In addition to WCIT, Services For Education can provide Instrument and Vocal Teaching in schools for individuals and small groups. We also provide instrumental and vocal teaching in special schools and alternative settings on an individual or small group basis.

Instruments involved include: Voice, DJ, violin, viola, cello, double bass, oboe, flute, clarinet, saxophone, bassoon, recorder, tin whistle, cornet, trumpet, french horn, tenor horn, baritone, euphonium, trombone, bass trombone, tuba, classical guitar, electric guitar, bass guitar, ukulele, keyboard, piano, drum kit, tuned percussion, diembe, steel pans, tabla, dhol, sitar, harmnium



All teaching is related to the National Curriculum, is supported by written pupil profiles and follows "A Common Approach," the nationally agreed curriculum.

These sessions are delivered by a trained workforce of specialist music teachers, all of whom undertake an enhanced DBS check and receive annual training in safeguarding, and the latest pedagogical techniques and trends.

SOUNDTOTS - EARLY YEARS MUSIC TEACHER

'Soundtots' is a musical intervention, for groups, aimed at helping children reach a progressive level of development during their time in the EYFS, supporting children's language development, memory, listening and attention skills.

Soundtots can be provided throughout the week to support the wider aims of school development plans by supporting children's language development, memory, listening and attention skills and raising children's learning outcomes across the seven areas of learning within the foundation stage.

SFE music teachers will foster and model the three 'characteristics of effective learning' so that children learn to explore, to be engaged and motivated to develop their thinking skills by making links in their learning through music.

MUSIC EXAMS AND ENSEMBLES

Each year during the summer term, the Services For Education Music Service organises examination sessions for the world-renowned ABRSM, Trinity, Rock School and London College of Music examination boards. We also offer graded world music practical exams in partnership with Pandit Ram Sahaj Sangit Vidyalaya (PRSSV).

This is a great opportunity for children to get acknowledgement and accreditation for their playing. Accompanists are provided and entries are processed by us. Our staff will advise when a pupil is ready to take an examination.


To ensure that pupils receive the best music education they possibly can, we offer a range of Music Resources to support our music tuition in schools.
